INTRODUCTION

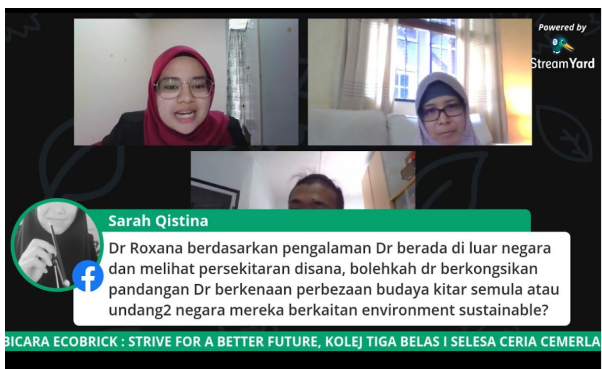

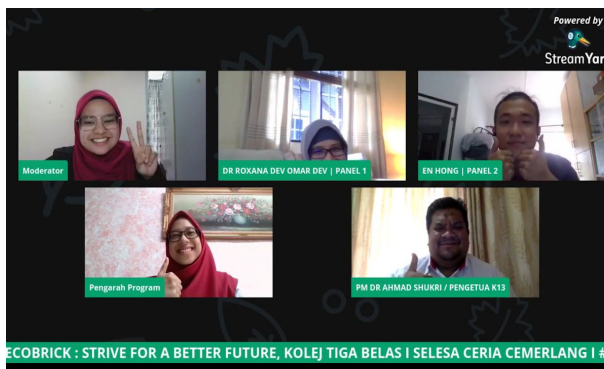
